

U.S. Judge Again Refuses To Drop Suit Against F.B.I.

A Federal judge Monday refused for the second time to dismiss a suit against J. Edgar Hoover and the Federal Bureau of Investigation seeking the surrender of documents that a leftist organization says were improperly seized.

United States Circuit Judge Harold R. Tyler ruled that the questions involved should be submitted to a trial. He had previously rejected, in April, the argument that his court lacked jurisdiction in the matter.
