Probe Ordered of FBI 'Conspiracy'

Seattle

A federal grand jury has been ordered to investigate an informer's charges that the FBI and the U.S. attorney here were involved in illegal conspiracies to obstruct justice.

The U.S. District Court order was based on charges brought yesterday by David Sannes, Seattle, against Stan Pitkin, U.S. attorney for western Washington, and the FBI.

Sannes alleges the FBI conspired in a bombing plan, in a felony, and in obstruction of justice, and that Pitkin has conspired to conceal such activities on the part of the FBI.

In the same court, Sannes, 29, pleaded guilty of improv-

erly disposing of rubbish — 3 pounds of cow manure — in the first - floor lobby of the U.S. Courthouse April 5 as a war protest.

He tried to include in his opening remarks alleged confessions of five persons admitting to conspiring to obstruct justice.

When Judge William T. Beeks ordered him to "stick to the issues," Sannes said he had been trying for about a year to bring into court his charges that the FBI instructed him as an informer to allow a bombing to take place and "to make sure that the man who set the bomb died in a booby-trapped explosion."

Beeks then ordered the government to take Sannes before a federal grand jury.
