**Secret Service Man
Held by City Police
For Shooting Gun**

A Secret Service agent, one of the team that guards the two children of the late President John F. Kennedy, was arrested here yesterday after he allegedly fired his revolver during an altercation with a taxi driver.

The agent was identified by the police of the Midtown North Squad as John J. List, 28 years old, of Bogota, N. J. He was booked at the West 54th

Street station on a charge of reckless endangerment.

A Washington spokesman for the Secret Service said later that "we are investigating the matter involving Agent List." He declined to say whether any disciplinary action was planned.

According to the police, Mr. List was allegedly cut off at 2:53 A.M. by a cab driver at Seventh Avenue and 53d Street. They said he pursued the cab in his car and then fired a shot over the hood of the taxi. He was arrested by Police Officer George Finmen, who had responded to the sound of gunfire.

Agent List is part of a team assigned to guard John F. Ken-

nedy Jr., who is 13 years old, and Carolyn, 15. The children of Presidents are guarded until they reach the age of 16.

Mrs. Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis, the President's widow, forfeited her Secret Service guard when she remarried.
