
Bremer Indicted

On 28 Counts

Federal and county grand juries yesterday indicted Arthur H. Bremer, 21, of Milwaukee, on 28 separate charges in the shooting of Democratic presidential contender George Wallace and three others May 15.

A Prince Georges County grand jury deliberated only 20 minutes in Upper Marlboro, Md., before returning four indictments of six counts each charging attempted murder, assault and violation of Maryland's new gun law in the shooting at a Laurel, Md., shopping center.

A few minutes later, a federal jury, in Baltimore returned an indictment charging Bremer with interfering with the civil rights of a candidate for federal office, two federal firearm law violations and assaulting a government agent.

The four county indictments were identical, with one for each of the victims. The charges carried penalties ranging up to death for attempted murder.

The federal charges carried penalties ranging up to ten years imprisonment and a \$10,000 fine.
