WITH WASHINGTON KENNEDY (A9)

MOSCOW, NOV. 2 (AP)-TASS TODAY DESCRIBED THE PLACING OF X-RAY PICTURES OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY IN THE NATIONAL ARCHIVES AS AN "ATTEMPT TO HIDE CLUES TO THE MYSTERY" OF HIS ASSASSINATION.
