NICOL, WHO TESTIFIED APRIL 1 BEFORE THE WARREN COMMISSION INVESTIGATING THE ASSASSINATION SAID TODAY HE WOULD NOT INDICATE
THE RELATION OF HIS TESTIMONY UNTIL THE COMMISSION ISSUES ITS REPORT.
