Los Angeles, Aug. 28 (AP)-An offocial of the John Birch Society says the Warren commission's report on the assassination of President John F. Kennedy will be "as complete Warren can get away with."

Dr. Revilo P. Foliver, member of the society's national council and a professor of classics at the University of Illinois, said the Warren commission is "illegal and unconstitutional," set up "on the demand of the Communist Party."

Only Texas state authorities, the House Committee on Un\*American Activities of the Senate subcommittee on Internal Security had the bagal right to investigate, Oliver said.

Oliver told a news conference he coubted the commission's report ever will be released. He said he had little hope it will bring out the truth.

"It depends on how much Sen. (Richard B.) Russell, D=Ga., who seems to be the American member of the commission, will submit to its suppression," Oliver added.

The professor said he based his opinion on Chief Justice Earl Warren's past performance and particularly Warren's "campaign to excite hysterical violence against American patriots."

Oliver is in Southern California for speaking engagements in nearby Glendale and Santa Ana.
