Warren Panel Reports To Johnson Thursday

WASHINGTON, Sept. 21
(AP) — President Johnson will receive Thursday the report of the Warren Commission's investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy.

George E. Reedy, White House press secretary, said the report would be made public over the weekend.

Mr. Johnson appointed the commission, under the chairmanship of Chief Justice Earl Warren, shortly after the slaying of Mr. Kennedy in Dallas, last Nov. 22. It has held extensive hearings and more than a quarter million words, Mr. Reedy said.
