(ADVANCE) LONDON, SEPT. 27 (AP)-PHILOSOPHER BERTRAND RUSSELL TONIGHT CALLED THE WARREN COMMISSION REPORT "A SORRILY INCOMPETENT DOCUMENT, AND IT COVERS ITS AUTHORS IN SHAME."

LORD RUSSELL HAD NOT READ THE REPORT BUT CLAIMED HE HAD BEEN FILLED IN BY TRANSATLANTIC TELEPHONE.

LORD RUSSELL, 92, SAID "IT IS CLEAR THAT MUCH IS STILL HIDDEN FROM THE PUBLIC." HE PLEDGED HIS "WHO KILLED KENNEDY COMMITTEE" TO RENEWED EFFORTS TO FIND "THE TRUE MURDERERS" OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

THE STATEMENT SAID "THE WARREN COMMISSION'S LACK OF INTEGRITY IS FULLY EXPOSED."

LORD RUSSELL WAS AT HIS HOME IN WALES TONIGHT WHILE HIS STATEMENT WAS ISSUED BY HIS AMERICAN-BORN SECRETARY, RALPH SCHOENMAN, AT A NEWS CONFERENCE IN LONDON.

THE STATEMENT, ISSUED IN RUSSELL'S CAPACITY AS CHAIRMAN OF THE BRITISH "WHO KILLED KENNEDY COMMITTEE," CHARGED:

"WE HAVE SEEN MEDICAL EVIDENCE ALTERED, THREE CONTRADICTORY OFFICIAL VERSIONS OF THE ASSASSINATION, THE CIRCULATION OF OSWALD'S DESCRIPTION AS TIPPIT'S MURDERER (J.D. TIPPIT WAS THE MURDERED POLICE OFFICER) MORE THAN TWENTY MINUTES BEFORE TIPPIT WAS SHOT, A FABRICATED REPORT FROM THE DALLAS AUTHORITIES, EYEWITNESSES IGNORED, LIES ABOUT THE NUMBER OF BULLETS--A PARADE OF DISTORTION AND DOCTORED EVIDENCE THESE FACTS HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED BY THE INVESTIGATIONS OF MARK LANE (A NEW YORK ATTORNEY WHO HEADS A CITIZENS' COMMITTEE OF INQUIRY).

ASKED BY REPORTERS WHETHER RUSSELL HAD READ THE WARREN REPORT, SCHOENMAN REPLIED THAT HE HAD NOT READ IT.

"BUT LORD RUSSELL HAD A TELEPHONE CONVERSATION WITH MR. LANE EARLY THIS MORNING. MR. LANE TOLD LORD RUSSELL ABOUT THE CONCLUSIONS REACHED BY THE WARREN COMMISSION," SCHOENMAN SAID.

ASKED HOW LANE HAD GOT HOLD OF THE WARREN COMMISSION'S CONCLUSIONS BEFORE PUBLICATION, SCHOENMAN REPLIED:

"MR. LANE TESTIFIED BEFORE THE SARREN COMMISSION. HE WAS SENT THAT PART OF THE REPORT WHICH CARRIED THE CONCLUSIONS. THIS HAS ENABLED MR. LANE TO REPLY TO THE CONCLUSIONS."

AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE BRITISH "WHO KILLED KENNEDY" COMMITTEE ARE LORD BOYD-ORR, FORMER HEAD OF THE WORLD FOOD AND AGRICULTURE ORGANIZATION; (FAO); PUBLISHERS JOHN CAULDER AND VICTOR GOLLANCZ; LABORITE LEGISLATOR MICHAEL FOOT; NOVELISTS AND WRITERS SIR COMPTON MACKENZIE AND J. B. PRIESTLEY; THE BISHOP OF SOUTHWARK; PROF. HUGH TREVOR ROPER OF OXFORD UNIVERSITY; AND KENNETH TYNAN, THEATER CRITIC.
