WARREN REPORT-OSWALD'S BROTHER (200)

DALLAS, SEPT. 27 (AP)-ROBERT OSWALD SAID TODAY THAT THERE IS NOW NO DOUBT IN HIS MIND THAT HIS BROTHER, LEE HARVEY OSWALD, WAS THE ASSASSIN OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

OSWALD, INTERVIEWED BY MURPHY MARTIN OF ABC IN THE WFAA-TV STUDIOS HERE, WAS ASKED HIS OPINION OF THE WARREN COMMISSION REPORT ON THE ASSASSINATION.

HE SAID THAT IN THE PAST HE HAD HAD DOUBTS ABOUT THE TIME FACTORS--- THE SHOTS FIRED FROM THE TEXAS SCHOOLBOOK DEPOSITORY BUILDING AND THE TIME THAT HIS BROTHER LEFT THE BUILDING UNTIL HIS ARREST IN A THEATER.

"I AM QUITE SATISFIED THAT IT HAS BEEN COVERED ENTIRELY AND LEAVES NO DOUBT IN MY MIND THAT LEE ACTUALLY DID ASSASSINATE THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES AND DID KILL OFFICER TIPPIT," OSWALD, 30, SALES MANAGER AT WICHITA FALLS, TEX., FOR A BRICK COMPANY, SAID.

"IS THERE ANY LINGERING DOUBT IN YOUR MIND REGARDING THE MOTIVE?" HE WAS ASKED.

"YES, THERE IS. THE COMMISSION REPORT GOES INTO A NUMBER OF POSSIBLE MOTIVES AND PROBABILITIES. TWO OR THREE COME CLOSE TO MY OWN PERSONAL THINKING ABOUT WHAT THE MOTIVE MIGHT HAVE BEEN," HE SAID OSWALD DID NOT ELABORATE ON THE STATEMENT.
