Former Major General Edwin A. Walker, calling the Warren Commission report a whitewash, said yesterday "there's bound to have been a plot" between Lee Harvey Oswald and his convicted killer, Jack

Ruby.

"It's perfectly obvious that there was enough relationship between Rubenstein and Oswald to prove there was a conspiracy," Walker said.

Ruby's name was Rubenstein until he had it legally changed to Ruby years ago. Walker accepted the War-

Walker accepted the Warren Commission conclusion that it was Oswald who shot at and narrowly missed him

on April 18, 1963.

Walker said it "should be obvious to everyone that Oswald was not working alone (in the attack on him) and that he had other contacts and associates. It vertainly appears there was some sort of conspiracy to a void bringing Oswald to light after he shot at me."
