WITH WARREN REPORT

MOSCOW, SEPT. 28 (AP)-THE U. S. EMBASSY SENT A COPY OF THE WARREN REPORT TO PREMIER KHRUSHCHEV TODAY.

THE REPORT IN ENGLISH, A NEWS STORY ON ITS CONTENTS COVERING SIX LEGAL-SIZED PAGES IN RUSSIAN, AND A PERSONAL LETTER FROM U. S. AMBASSADOR FOY KOHLER WERE SENT TO THE KREMLIN.

SIMILAR PACKAGES WERE ALSO SENT TO ABOUT 100 OTHER TOP SOVIET OFFICIALS AND NEWSPAPER EDITORS, A U. S. EMBASSY SPOKESMAN SAID. HE ADDED THAT THE FIRST CHAPTER OF THE REPORT, WHICH SUMMARIZES IT, WOULD SOON BE READY IN RUSSIAN AND A RUSSIAN TRANSLATION OF A LONGER SUMMARY IS BEING PREPARED.
