WARREN REPORT-COSTS

WASHINGTON, SEPT. 30 (AP)-THE COSTS OF THE INVESTIGATION AND REPORT OF THE COMMISSION WHICH INVESTIGATED THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY ARE UNDETERMINED AS YET, OFFICIALS SAID TODAY.

"WE DON'T KNOW YET; THERE IS SOME WINDING UP TO DO AND THE PRINTERS ARE UNFINISHED," ELMER B. STAATS, DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF THE BUDGET BUREAU, TOLD A REPORTER.

PRINTERS STILL ARE WORKING ON THE 20-ODD VOLUMES OF HEARINGS THAT WILL FOLLOW THE REPORT WHICH WAS MADE PUBLIC LAST SUNDAY.

NO ESTIMATE OF COSTS WAS AVAILABLE.

WHEN PRESIDENT JOHNSON CREATED THE COMMISSION LAST NOV. 30, HE SAID ITS NECESSARY EXPENSES MAY BE PAID FROM THE EMERGENCY FUND FOR THE PRESIDENT. THIS IS A MISCELLANEOUS FUND SET AT \$1 MILLION ANNUALLY FOR THE LAST SEVERAL YEARS FROM WHICH VARIOUS EMERGENCIES ARE PAID.
