Weisberg quotes from tape recording of remarks by Wesley Liebeler, 2 May 67, who describes his personal re-writing of section of Warren Report dealing with visit of three men to Sylvia Odio. Liebeler says "on the night of the 20th or 21st of September when we were going over the page proofs of the Report for the last time," a report was received from J. Edgar Hoover that the men had been found; he rewrote the section that night and sent it to the Government Printing Office. Weisberg points out that no member of the Commission saw this before it was published.

Weisberg says that Liebeler also tells of rewriting the Report to conclude that "Leon Oswald" could not have been "Lee Oswald."
