

WARREN WILL LEAD CENTER FOR PEACE

Chief Justice Earl Warren has accepted the chairmanship of the International Board of Overseers of the International Center for the Advancement of Peace, now nearing completion on Mount Scopus in Jerusalem.

Announcement of the appointment was made Wednesday by former President Harry S. Truman in a statement issued from Independence, Mo.

"The center, which bears my name, will devote itself to the advancement and encouragement of the ways of peace among nations and to advocate the banishment of war as an instrument of foreign policy," he said.

"I regard it as fortunate that the center will be led in its work for peace by Chief Justice Warren, whose reputation in the world community symbolizes justice, understanding and compassion for all peoples of all nations."
