

12/22/70 Unless you think it necessary for a complete library, if you haven't bought A Heritage of Stone (recommended subtitle, The Laboring Mountain), don't. There is nothing new in it but error, persuasively as it is done, and most people- all but a very, very small number, will be deceived by it and led to believe white is black.

The factual error is incredible (like Oswald twice arrested for distributing literature, an enterprise that he engaged in but three times, whereas he did it often).

Even the demigod is misrepresented, which is not to his credit.

There is always a serious problem, working with the material of others without their understanding of it, and it is compounded if scruple is lacking.

This unfortunate thing is the tragedy's monument to the tragedy.
