

The 12/17/72 Wash Post was at least as large as usual, had atleast as much ad space as usual (heavily Xmas), but had no single ref to WG, not even in the columns I saw. Nor a story by Woodward of Bernstein or the others working on WG. Even the long Malek piece DEC 18 1972 makes no reference to it. Nothing on the strange death of Dorothy Hunt. Nor Jack Anderson's column. I've been getting the Post since the mid-30s and can't remember another case. Under Pearson occasionally editors would eliminate and would get pressure.
