Today's Post had nothing and my recollection of what I heard as I was rousing is very unclear. I started to get up to start working about 3:30 or 4, then decided against it and slept until close to 5:30, which let me get a fair start. Well, as I was rousing the first time, I didn't realize until it was at the end that the Westinghouse B'Casting news had an item on Hunt and some other name. While I was shaving and brewing the coffee after I did get up, it was before they had to switch to their daytime pattern. I listened until ready to work, but they didn't repeat. When I went for a walk later listened to WTOP, CBS all-news. In that 45 minutes, for most of which on the set I took I could hear them, no Hunt item at all and no new WG News. Otherwise, no news todat at all. ... Surpised to see Bernstein's byline without Woodward's. First time since they started working on the story together.
