JDW: As the enclosed to HM shows, I'm not at all certain that the time I've decided to put in on the House investigation is justified. I am certain it is not a waste, however. The time is a crucial one. Just about everyone who is doing anything is doing what serves official interests. I have had other plans for the time but I could not have thought of any continuous work until after Friday's court eession. My hunch is that whether or not I can do what I'm trying the effort is necessary. I don't know whether Bud can influence Downing. On the 18th Morrow was speaking highly of Bud and assuring his audience that 'ud would be counsel. But I think that Bud has finally come to understand how he can be hurt in all of this. Maybe he'll give it the college try. He'll be m uch better off if he tries and fails than he is now. He may see it. Best, HW 9/28/76
