There is no end to it. All this, save perhaps McDonald, is pouring in on the Church committee. McDonald says they can't wait for him to appear. And arming DJ. Popkin has seen to it personally.

In this case there are other complication that can't be avoided.
With the others I'm silent. The more they destroy themselves, which I can't prevent,
the less harm they can do in the future.

There is, of course, also harm from them in the present.

I hope they all now take the hangout road and get it all over with, as best it can be all over with when the nuts are loose.
