Dear Harold:

Your mailing of the 3rd came yesterday, bringing the good news of your continued recovery. Sounds fine, and we know you'll think twice before doing anything to jeopardize it. Do be careful. The lift in your spirits is apparent, and now is the time to watch yourself.

When and if you can get around to it, if it's at all possible, we have a small request. The WX Post has resumed coming as of Oct. 27th issue. As far as we know we need nothing from the period missed from Oct. 1 to 26th except for one thing: that is the story in the early editions of Oct. 17 (they were on the street the night before) about Kissinger's remarks before an open mike in Ottawa about Nixon. This is according to the NY Times, which rewrote a story from the Post. It's probable that the Times version has everything the Post had that's worth carrying, but just in case the Times left something out we'd appreciate a photocopy of the Post version, if you have it, if and when you're doing some copying anyway and can run it in along with the stuff you're doing for yourself. No hurry; we just want it for the record. If you don't have it, or if you aren't operating the copier these days, no matter.

On another matter, I've been in touch recently with Linda Ferguson, the girl who does the quarterly book review section for the Pacific Sun here in Mill Valley. It's quite a production, the main drawback being that it appears only every ~~four months~~ three months. They're using a review I've done of a new book, The UFO Controversy in America, by a Ph. D. historian named Jacobs. It's an important book, and what I've done is to indicate the importance of the UFO coverup in relation to others that followed. It'll appear late this month, at which time I'll send you a copy.

In any case, since the Sun has used considerable material on the assassinations, I asked Linda if she'd like a review of Howard's book. She said yes, but that it would have to wait until the next quarterly in March. She also said she'd have to clear it with you, as you had written to them about Howard's book in glowing terms and she had written back asking you to review it but had heard nothing from you. We only recently got Howard's book through a local bookstore after quite a long delay while it was ordered specially. I told her you had been busy finishing up your own book, PM, among many other things. She wanted to know all about that, and I told her only that it was about ready but you hadn't decided when to release it. She then suggested we wait on Howard's book and review it along with yours. I told her that would be okay with me, assuming it was with you, and that in any case there was no need to hurry a decision since the next quarterly won't be along until March. I also pointed out that by that time things might be quite different in respect to the whole situation, that the whole coverup could come apart in the meantime.

That's the way the situation stands now, and in any case I can do nothing until PM arrives. In the meantime if you have any preferences please feel free to indicate them. I know that the Sun now and then carries book reviews in their weekly regular edition, in between the quarterlies, so I'm hoping to work something along that line and not have to wait until next March.

Meanwhile, thanks for keeping your eye peeled for stories on The Two while we were cut off from the Post. Even the NY Times used it a couple of times. I still regard it as a Department of Disinformation operation, as also probably is the cattle mutilation story which has been boiling up simultaneously throughout the country. (We have the one from the Post for Oct. 29). The increased activity along this line suggests that some fairly important revelations may be coming up, probably unavoidably, and that the country is being confused systematically in order to minimize the impact of any real information that may be forthcoming. For instance, any such revelations need not be entirely unavoidable, but purposefully leaked in order to distract public attention from the disintegration of public confidence in the security agencies and in such other official myths as the WR. They're all related. And the UFO coverup preceded all the others and provided many of the techniques with which we have all become so familiar.
