Agnew to Speak To Nation Monday

Former Vice President Spiro T. Agnew was conspicuously absent from Friday night's White House gathering where President Nixon named House Republican Leader Gerald R. Ford as Agnew's successor.

A spokesman said Agnew was presumably watching the event on television from his suburban Maryland home after having asked two broadcast networks for time to make a speech of his own on Monday night.

NBC said it would give Agnew television time at 7:30 p.m. (EDT) Monday and CBS said Agnew would be on its radio network at 8 p.m. ABC had not been contacted.
