Q. When Spiro Agnew goes to Greece as he recently did, does he have to clear such overseas trips with his probation officer? Also, why was Dale Anderson, who was Baltimore County Executive just as Agnew was, sent to jail for five years, and Agnew didn't pull a single night in the pokey?—Mrs. Allen L., Baltimore, Md.

A. Spiro Agnew is on unsupervised probation for three years; which means he can go anywhere anytime he wants to without the permission of any probation officer. As regards Dale Anderson's sentence of five years in jail for the same kind of crimes Agnew was connected with, one must remember that justice in this country is frequently unequal, depending upon one's position and finances.
