

Jim, not until I picked up TIME dated 5/21/73 this morning did I realize how careless I've been in overlooking something that must be a great investigative lead and could, without investigation, tell us some things. It is the pocket addressbooks taken from the Cubans by the Washington police and I think used in evidence by the prosecution. The one a small facsimile of which was used by TIME (p.17) is quite neat and has to have been made up after 4/17/71 unless Barker perjured himself. (He testified that is the first time he had seen Hunt in 10 years.) Because it lists Liddy as "George" I have no doubt it was compiled after 4/71. Or, after the beginning of the Nixon Gestapo. It might lead to other crimes and activities, could tell us the kinds of associates these people had (and I'd not exclude the Walker and Hargis type in conjecturing), or other Cubans who, in turn, may have been involved in unexposed jobs. It also might add up to nothing without considerable work. But I think it is worth the effort, if you can get to the courthouse, to copy it. I'd like a facsimile of the Hunt page in any event. If an effort is made to deny it, I think use by TIME waives any proper right. If as I may, I ask Raul Ramirez to get a copy, I'll let you know. He has been in touch with me. HW 6/2/73
