Ehrlichman testified 7/27, at one of the many points where he was just rambling to avoid direct answer, that in a discussion with Kalmbach at San Clemente, he had taken Kalmbach out of Ehr's office, for a walk, for this sensitive talk. Earlier he had testified to arranging it so that both of his admitted conferences with Judge Byrne would also be outside. One of these was while they were walking toward the bluff at San Clemente. The explanation for this was as rational as Kiddy's offering to stand on a street-corner so the CREEP's could assassinate him. The other was in a Santa Monica park. He took Kalmbach to his car for the third of these outside-Ehrlichman's on-office sensitive talks. It made me wonder if there was an automatic bugging device in Ehrlichman's San Clemente office.
