## **M'GOVERN LETTERS** DISCOVERED MISSING

Correspondance between the 1972 Democratic Presidential nominee, Senator George Mc-Govern, and the senior part-ner in the Wall Street broker-age firm of Unterberg (C.E) Towbin Company was dis-covered missing during the campaign last fall.

campaign last fall. Belmont Towbin, a senior partner in the firm, and a financial contributor and sup-porter of the Senator, said there had been no sign of forcible entry to get the letters. "There was nothing especially sensitive in the let-ters," said Mr. Towbin, when asked yesterday about the re-port. "Just the conventional social kind of correspondance, including some articles about

including some articles about the campaign that I had cut out and sent to him."

Because the letters contained no "sensitive" material and be-cause there was no sign of a break-in, the incident was not reported, Mr. Towbin said.
