GAO Accuses

Ky. Democrat Of Hiding Funds

FRANKFORT, Ky., July 26 (AP)—The General Accounting Office released an audit Thursday charging that J.R. Miller, former chairman of the Kentucky Democratic Party, had deliberately concealed the existence, in a Frankfort, Ky., bank, of \$14,000 in unreported party funds.

The report, covering 1972, was called "one of the most serious" ever issued by the agency in its role as overseer of political committees and campaign financing.

The report also said that Miller instructed an accountant for the state Democratic Central Executive Committee not to report a \$3,000 transaction with the AFL-CIO in the spring 1972.
