Sources in the prosecutor's office cited three reasons for the Kennedy flavor among the early staff recruits:

GBecause so many of the possible Watergate defendants had a conection with the Justice Department during the Nixon Administration, it would not have been appropriate to dip into the department's present staff for personnel; that would have blown Mr. Cox's independenc out of the water almost before he started.
