Dean, already disbarred by Virginia and banned from practicing law in the U.S. District Court here, is serving a prison sentence of one to four years for his confessed role in the Watergate cover-up. He is being kept at a nearby facility in order to be available to testify in the cover-up trial of five fomer Nixon aides that began this week.
