Watergate Burglar To Serve 2 Terms

MIAMI, Jan. 9 (UPI)— Convicted Watergate burglar Frank Sturgis was sentenced today to nine months in jail for transporting stolen cars to Mexico.

The sentence, handed down by U.S. District Judge C. Clyde Atkins, will be served after Sturgis is paroled March 7 from the federal prison at Eglin Air Force Base where he is serving his Watergate sentence.

Sturgis was sentenced to two nine-month terms, but Atkins ruled they could be served concurrently. Sturgis and two other defendants were convicted Nov. 30 of transporting stolen cars from Florida to Mexico.

The defense argued they did not know the cars were stolen.
