MRS. FORD WILL TOUR WHITE HOUSE TODAY

WASHINGTON, Aug. 11 (UPI)—Mrs. Gerald R. Ford will visit the White House family quarters tomorrow to make plans for moving into her new home.

The wives of outgoing Presidents normally show their successors around the Executive Mansion and introduce them to the household staff.

But this transition was so extraordinary that there was no opportunity for that kind of amenity, and it is the chief usher, Rex Scouten, who will take Mrs. Ford on a tour of the third-floor family suite where the Richard M. Nixons lived until last Friday.

The Fords are expected to remain at their colonial brick and white frame home in suburban Alexandria, Va., until the last of this week, and when they move out they will rent it. The Fords have lived in the house, built to their specifications in 1955, in the middle-class neighborhood of Seminary Hill, and they promised their four children that they would not sell it.
