Future shock has struck again on my correspondence to you.

My letter dated Oct. 10, which included mention of Vice-President Agnew, was posted that morning but even as it was being processed in the Zion post office a few hours later Agnew was convicted of tax evasion and vacated his office.

Also, the letter had a reference to a book which now has new and possibly important significance in view of the nomination of Congressman Ford as Agnew's designated successor. If you have not already read The Washington Pay-Off, you might find of particular interest the 31-page chapter titled "Richard Nixon, Jerry Ford and other Tarnished Heroes, or: How to Buy an Ambassadorship for \$125,000." Some of the allegations could be worthy of congressional scrutiny in connection with the forthcoming confirmation hearings.
