LOGAN, Utah—Vice President Ford's son, John, says he doesn't think his father will run for President.

The younger Ford, a forestry student at Utah State University, said he worked for President Nixon's reelection in 1972. "But of late, I have become disillusioned with him," he said in an interview in the Salt Lake City Tribune yesterday.

John, 22, said he did not believe his father would run for President. "There is no way I want to get into politics, and I can't thing of anything worse than my father going through a national campaign.

"I know it will be hard for him to walk away since he has put so much time into politics, but I am sure he will retire after this term," he said.
