Dear Mr. Captain, On the Bay of Pigs, a somewhat different perspective may yet help. Your Agent Hunt visited prior to the arrests at the interrogate.

You may not recall me and my writing from earlier correspondence. You are then and in what has come to be called the Watergate Case, said to be centered around a possible charge of robbery against Bernard Barker. I write on the chance I may be in a position to help you. Not knowing the extent of your interest, which is not reported elsewhere above all which really is not properly my business, I don't know. In my job, I take stock.

In I have seen an earlier Miami newspaper clipping and it leaves a mystery about Hunt which is not at all mysterious and might be within the scope of your inquiry. It has to do with part of his recent life when he was with Dr. Ricardo part of his CIA life, at least, if not of one or more other careers. The reporter who wrote that story was not a good very good investigator. In consulted 1972 sources for 1965 events, and if he's a known sort, perhaps four more years and involved others. I refer to what you may have seen, Hunt's connection with what your paper called the firm of Leitner and Wilkinson.

By the most remarkable of coincidences, his connection with that firm of attorney agents, for that is what it was, closely coincided with something sent them by the Central Intelligence Agency, then preparing a deal for use of parts of my first book. That took a solid part of Oswald's career that it was consistent with intelligence only. CIA "until" interest in this one angle ought require no exposition. In a relatively short time this deal was killed, for reasons then obviously and soon enough proven false, when that chapter was replaced in another dealing with no literary-agency midman. When the agent had the seen a little unusual that a seemingly set deal was killed by the agency with which Hunt is claimed an affiliation then and continuing through his 1969 Who's Who listing? He is not, by the way, on their 1969 Who's Who, nor in the alleged Washington office he also claims as his. However, some of the reporting of it is false, not the fault of the reporters, for they reported what they were told. If they had investigated what they were told, they would have learned the truth. Of course, I do not know whether or how this may interest you.

In short areas you and your staff should know about Miami Cubans that D. B. Miller's operation with you, a matter on which I do have an opinion. I do have some entirely inadequate FBI reports on Fiorini and Suarez, whose less than was known to the Bureau was included. These relate to threats against President Kennedy. That was part of Marcelino Rosenberg's Free Cuba Committee. I believe the funding an one year was \$500,000. This is the Robert R. Wilson agency. I have a tip I have not checked, that Wilson is a key Dicynne neighbor of the President. Hunt was simultaneously part of the White House staff and part of the agency, as I assume you know, though proven false, given that disclaimer.
