Senator Demands

Panel Be Disbanded
PHILADELPHIA, April
13, (AP)— U.S. Sen. Richard S. Schweiker (R-Pa.), called today for immediate disbandment of the Committee for the Re-election of the President, calling its deep involvement in the "sordid" Watergate affair "a blot on the name and future of the Republican Party."

"Its continued existence

raises fundamental questions about its true role and purpose," Schweiker said in a statement.

"The election has been over for nearly six months. Stories about its involvement in the Watergate keep appearing daily about alleged payoffs and coverups. . . It has come to stand for everything the party is against."
