

1968 campaign chief of staff. Became WH chief of Staff. Administ, not exec. "The boss of the WH" involving the WH budget but says not on policy, which was handled by others, like Kissinger, Laird, etc. Spent more time with GL than anyone else.

Had adm. goals & received secretaries "Staff secretary" handled staff plans for Strategic & his 'it off' activities "High" "communicative function" helping him run with him at Thompson & Hough campaign. Closest assistant. Also Strategic.

Brought EH into 1960 campaign

Deen got assignments from Pres. via Haldeman. Deen also reported direct to Pres.

"I tried to run a tight ship." Quoted "some who dedicated to the task felt the whip was useful sometime." "Tried to run a zero-defect system"; to make no mistakes.

Keep consult-memos. To stay to be "headlined as the WH" is to say nothing about Nelson, because that goes to a large group of national committee. Why not him, "because the Natl Com is the official body of the Repub. today" and helps all GOP candidates for all offices. Wanted to attack others - Deen's, independents.

"After ego like the WH?" "I don't think so."

H's role in it: talking with WH staff only with his o.k. Strategic his (negotiation). Rebuttal 2/3/72 memo in general ~~of~~^{with} budget. P. 2 ref to staff & Wilson "\$900,000 for Wilson office" and \$90,000 for "black" projects (most for marching) "most of government contacts" with various groups Wilson's. Not sure "if what "black" projects memo. He calls this "campaign support by the WH" if approved memo noted ~~noted~~ "close communication & cooperation with Mitchell."

"1970 was the year of concern with domestic security" concerns led to Huston plan. Huston had done preliminary work on "the problem". He & Huston set in on GL's entry with top experts. They called "foreign" help here were "organizations that were "out to destroy the country" & they didn't get facts. This really means there was no proof & the press reports were wrong. (Actually, there was more violence follows GL's organization) ("Foreign" help - compare GL's deal with China, USSR) "Huston reported same in that particular case" & "Saw the recommendations that went to the Pres." "Knew Hoover disagreed. Huston sought H's help on over-coming & did get memo on it from him.

8/5/70 memo to him from Huston on "Domestic intelligence", dealing with Hoover's opposition.

Haston would have been over room on us.
Kew H. approve. Tap not implemented - recorded 5 days later. Think
cause Horner objections. Mitchell put it up to hearing then H & H to oppose,
but H says does not recall.

Later "in house White House unit." Begun as IEC, which had
"one of the purposes of the Huston plan"; inter-agency coordination.

Dean WH liaison with military and operations.
S/11 1971 - "Even though a unit had been set up at the Pres'
request" with Young & Moqz 2 in general ~~top~~ responsibility. Hunt &
Liddy ask "I guess so" asked if he "supposedly" knew of new budgetary
privileges given personnel didn't have to pass through him.
Each part W/H had its own budget, then a special one from Congress.
Knew of Sandusky plan which "sort of dropped dead of its own
weight, which is confirmation of Dean."

Knew Liddy to keep before 6/17/72. Knew New was question of Liddy's
salary - unless over what he got at W/H

Knew of Creep, spy meetings in Marshall's office, possibly b/c Dean
and how "inconceivable" they were. Tap "he had turned the plan off" would not be
in any such circumstances W/H should not be in any. Records 1/71 + 1/72 as
dates. Log shows 2/1/72 mtg with Dean. No other Dean-IT mtg Jan, Feb 1/72.
His log kept by secretary who "recorded ... every phone" except leaving.
Accurate, with times, dates. Potential inaccuracies "re tapes outside
his office when SEC. not with him."

Strachan & Pd. matters H 18 memo, doesn't "recall" telling St. to
put it that files were "clean". No instructions to him from emphasis from
Marshall. Has "very high opinion" of this "honesty" & "loyalty" & "thoroughness"

Was at Key Biscayne hotel when he learned of break-in. GL & Walters
Cyg. learned 18th Sunday, from May. of Creep involvement. He & GL
returned to DC ^{date} Evening 19th mtg a.m. 20th with Marshall, Hunt &
in part Dean & H. There. Other mtgs 23, 26 don't show. Marshall
told to Dean by phone.

CIA mtg 6/23/72 Walters "in effect" ordered H to see Gray & hold
FBI back & GL told him FBI worried about CIA involvement
"There were other matters of concern... Whether investigation... could
possibly impugn upon ^{integrity}: the activities of some of the individuals
who had been involved in the W.G. & who had been exonerated
at the W.G."

Dennis Deen told him of Mtg's "problem".
Matchill report on W.H. bonus - didn't recall Matchill telling him &
did not know or from (Learned later)

"I don't know" when asked of "The use of political campaign funds
would undermine the President." But the "whole situation" had
been an immediate embarrassment to h.
