However, what this fortifies is my belief from the time I heard that the effort would be made to pin rap on CIA that a possible reason for ousting Helms is his nixing Nixon on this. Remember my boting how unusual it was that so close to retirement Helms was offed? I then though two thing, as I recall: effort to get political control, which McC here says his own way; and to give military what they wanted of intelligence, which he also says in a similar way. Any one of these things could have caused it, but it now appears to me that the one that would prompt GL to axe a career man so close to (honorable) retirement is vengeance, and the most like cause refusal to take a fall. What is in some ways more fascinating is that Hunt also was out to get CIA, was bitter. Whodthunkit, expecially CIA under Nixon, Hunt's type. Or, Hant ain't all that loyal to fellow spooks.
