Cuban Exiles Raise \$3,000

For 4 Guilty in Break-In

MIAMI, April 20 (UPI)—A

14-man committee from Miami's Cuban exile colony has raised between "\$3,000 and \$4,000" to aid four Miami area men who pleaded guilty to breaking into the Democratic party's headquarters in the Watergate complex in Washington last June.

The money is deposited in five accounts, one in the name of the "Miami Watergate Defendants' Relief Fund" and one in the name of each of the four men. They are Bernard L. Barker, Eugenio R. Martinez, Virgilio T. Gonzalez and Frank A. Sturgis.
