> Hunt had worked for the CIA and his name, along with notations indicating he was connected with the White House, were found in the address books of two of the suspects. He has not been seen in public since the FBI questioned him shortly after the break-in at Democratic party offices.

An unloaded pistol and walkie-talkie equipment similar to that found with the suspects were located by the FBI in Hunt's desk at the Executive Office Building next to the White House. Hunt's most recent employment was with a public relations firm, but he has not appeared for work since the break-in.

Mrs. Hunt has been dismissed from a part-time job as an interpreter at the Spanish Embassy in Washington, the embassy confirmed. A spokesman said Monday this was because of the political nature of the break-in and the mystery surrounding her husband.
