Senate Limits Funds for Nixon

The Senate voted yesterday to deny all but \$200,000 of the \$850,000 recommended by President Ford to help former President Nixon return to private life.

The transition funds were contained in an \$8.3 billion catch-all supplemental appropriations bill, adopted 65 to 18.

Although many of the provisions in the bill will have to be reconciled between Senate and House allocations, the Nixon funds will be held to \$200,000 because the two chambers approved identical amounts.

Under provisions of the Senate and House bills, Mr. Nixon would receive \$100,000 of the \$450,000 requested for trans-

ition costs and \$100,000 of the \$400,000 asked for pension and allowances.
