Freed of Marijuana Charge
GAINSVILLE, Fla., Sept. 3.
(AP)—Scott Camil, an antiwar activist, was acquitted yesterday of two marijuana charges and said that he had overcome a bigger obstacle than the Federal conspiracy charge he faces next month.

The 26-year-old decorated marine veteran is one of ix members of the Vietnam Veterans Against the War facing trial in October on charges of conspiring to disrupt last month's Republican National Convention in Miami Beach with bombs. with bombs.

Law enforcement officials now say, however, that members of the group were not involved in the violence that erupted on the closing night of the convention Aug. 23.
