## Judge Forbids All Comment On VVAW Case PENSACOLA, Fla., July 14

PENSACOLA, Fla., July 14 (AP)—A ban on further public comment has been imposed against persons involved in the July 31 trial of eight men charged with conspiring to disrupt last year's Republican National Convention.

U.S. District Judge Winston Arnow ordered the ban Friday against further public comment on the basis that the eight antiwar activists charged have shown conduct "designed to impede the course of justice."

Seven Vietnam War Veterans Against the War, VVAW members and one supporter are charged with planning violence at the convention.
