In Baton Rouge, Thomas Burbank, superintendent of state police, said his department once bought "anti-bugging" equipment from a New Orleans firm headed by Novel after a 1965 report that the governor's office was being "bugged" with hidden microphones.

"We never did find any equipment in the office," said Burbank.

Records in the Louisiana secretary of state's office list an Electronics Systems International as filing papers June 27, 1966, listing Novel among the incorporators.

Dean Andrews, recently indicted on a perjury charge by the grand jury in the conspiracy probe, was listed as attorney for the firm .
