NEW ORLEANS (AP)-THE NATIONAL BROADCASTING COMPANY'S CHARGE THAT
GARRISON PROBE WITNESS PERRY RUSSO FAILED A LIE DETECTOR TEST WAS
DISPUTED TUESDAY BY THE MAN WHO SUPERVISED THE TEST.

IN A SIGNED STATEMENT, PRIVATE INVESTIGATOR LEONARD GURVICH SAID
THAT THE POLYGRAPH OPERATOR WAS UNABLE TO GET A READING ON RUSSO
AFTER MAKING TWO ATTEMPTS TO ADMINISTER THE TEST.

NBC COMMENTATOR FRANK MCGEE MADE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT MONDAY
ON THE TELEVISION NETWORK'S "WHITE PAPER" PROGRAM: "RUSSO'S
ANSWERS TO A SERIES OF QUESTIONS INDICATE, IN THE LANGUAGE OF THE
POLYGRAPH OPERATOR, DECEPTION CRITERIA. HE WAS ASKED IF HE KNEW
CLAY SHAW. HE WAS ASKED IF HE KNEW LEE HARVEY OSWALD. HIS "YES"
ANSWERS TO BOTH OF THESE QUESTIONS INDICATED DECEPTION CRITERIA."
IN A STATEMENT DATED JUNE 19. GURVICH SAYS THAT HE SET UP THE
TEST AND WAS PRESENT WHILE IT WAS ATTEMPTED. HE DESCRIBED THE
PROCEEDINGS THIS WAY:
"IT WAS DETERMINED BY THE OPERATOR THAT THE SUBJECT. PERRY
RUSSO, WAS HIGHLY NERVOUS AND THAT HE COULD NOT DETERMINE RELEVANCY
OR IRRELEVANCY DUE TO HIS PRESENT STATE. A SHORT TIME WAS ALLOTED
TO ALLOW THE SUBJECT TO ENGAGE IN CONVERSATION WITH THE POLYGRAPH
OPERATOR, MR. ANDREW SCIAMBRA AND MYSELF. THIS WAS DONE IN THE
HOPE THAT WE WOULD BE ABLE TO MAKE A LITTLE EASIER THE CONDITIONS
FOR THE TESTING OF MR. RUSSO.

"AFTER A SHORT PAUSE. A SECOND ATTEMPT WAS MADE TO TEST MR.
RUSSO AND AGAIN THE POLYGRAPH OPERATOR ADVISED THAT HE WAS UNABLE TO
GET SPECIFIC READINGS."

GURVICH SAID THAT TO THE BEST OF HIS KNOWLEDGE, RUSSO WAS NOT
TESTED AT THAT TIME. HE ADDED THAT HE WAS NOT AWARE OF ANY OTHER

NBC ALLEGED THAT GARRISON KNEW THAT RUSSO HAD FAILED THE TEST WHEN HE PUT HIM ON THE STAND AT THE PRELIMINARY HEARING OF CLAY L. SHAW. THE TEST WAS MADE, SAID NBC, SIX DAYS BEFORE RUSSO GAVE HIS TESTIMONY.

AT THE HEARING, RUSSO, A 25-YEAR-OLD BATON ROUGE INSURANCEMAN, TESTIFIED THAT HE OVERHEARD CLAY L.SHAW DISCUSSING AN ASSASSINATION PLOT WITH DAVID W.FERRIE AND LEE HARVEY OSWALD. RUSSO SAID THE PLOT WAS HATCHED AT A PARTY AT FERRIE'S APARTMENT IN SEPTEMBER, 1963. KENNEDY WAS ASSASSINATED ON NOV.22, 1963.

LARGELY ON THE BASIS OF RUSSO'S TESTIMONY, THE ORLEANS PARISH GRAND JURY INDICTED SHAW FOR CONSPIRACY TO ASSASSINATE THE PRESIDENT. WHEN ASKED WHAT HE THOUGHT OF NBC'S PROGRAM ON THE PROBE, GARRISON SAID, "I DIDN'T WATCH IT. I HAVE BETTER THINGS TO DO WITH MY TIME."
