

DA Withdraws Subpena for Oil Consultant

A Kennedy death plot investigation subpoena issued for an international petroleum engineer and consultant has been withdrawn by the District Attorney's office.

However, there were indications today that the object of the subpoena, William Dalzell, may talk with members of the DA's office sometime this weekend.

Dalzell, reportedly an oil consultant to the Ethiopian government, was subpoenaed to appear in the DA's office at 1 p. m. yesterday. Sheriff's deputies manned a stakeout on his room at the Roosevelt Hotel.

The subpoenaed man could not be found, and the summons was withdrawn. But informed sources said the withdrawal was made only after assurances that Dalzell could be located.

There was no immediate indication of what questions the DA's office wants to ask Dalzell, who was an incorporator of a militant anti-Castro organization here in early 1961.
