**Ochsner Granted  
Cancer Study Aid**

Alton Ochsner Medical Foundation has received a grant of \$256,530 for breast cancer research from the Department of Health, Education and Welfare.

The three-year grant will bolster research projects involving care and treatment of breast-cancer patients as well as management services for the National Cancer Institute.

Dr. Albert Segaloff, director of endocrine research at Ochsner, was largely responsible for the experimental design used

internationally in breast cancer studies. Dr. Segaloff serves as chairman of the Cooperative Breast Cancer Group, which includes 25 cooperating medical research centers throughout the nation.
