L. A. 'Suspect' Named By Garrison Arraigned

Judge Aisenson continued the case for 30 days pending eytradition proceedings by Louisiana authorities. Bradley was ordered to come back to court Jan. 29.

The charges against Bradley were filed by New Orleans district attorney Jim Garrison.

Bradley has stated he was in Dallas only once in his life and that was last spring when he passed through there on a vacation trip.
