

Criminal District Court judge Matthew S. Brannif isued the subpoenas and orered the men to appear beore the Orleans Parish rand jury February 1 and 2. he documents said the three rould be granted immunity rom arrest for anything hapening prior to their entry ato Louisiana.

The subpoena for Hall, who s also known as Lorenzo ascillo, said Garrison had nformation that Hall hecked into the Dallas 'MCA in October, 1963, and emained in Dallas until the ime of Mr. Kennedy's death here on Nov. 22, 1963.



Hall said he would "be in

Los Angeles Saturday to fight that . . . right down the line.'

Hall said he had been in Texas during the time the subpoena noted and that he had been active for one year in the "Free Cuba" movement in 1963.

But he denied ever meeting Oswald, Ruby, Ferrie "or anyone else involved in the assassinatioon or anyone ever mentioned by Garrison or anybody else."

Hall, a bartender in Wofford Heights, Calif., 125 miles northeast of Los Angeles, said he had been in Louisiana "once, back in 1963 and that was for about 31/2 hours while I was driving through to Miami."

In Omaha, Beckham, 27, a church bishop and country music singer, said he knows nothing of the Kennedy assassination and is being sought by Garrison for "trumped up" charges.

Beckham said that such a trip to New Orleans would be a "waste of taxpayers' money" and would serve "only to feather the nest of Garrison."
