## O'Hara Case Hearing Set March 14

Testimony will be taken at a closed hearing March 14 in the state's suit to remove Criminal District Court Judge Malcolm V. O'Hara from office.

Michael M. Irwin was appointed by the Louisiana Supreme Court to compile a record. The court itself will conduct a trial of the case on May 3.

Judge O'Hara is accused of attempting to obtain evidence to overturn Federal Court convictions in Chattanooga of Teamsters Union President James R. Hoffa and former New Orleans builder Zachary A. Strate.

The hearing is expected to take two or three days. Afterward, the record will be submitted to the court without any suggestion as to its disposition.

When filed with the court the record will become public. Trial of the case also will be open to the public.
