Garrison: Ordinarily, you would expect that it would be possible to look at the 18 color photographs and 12 black and white photos of the autopsy and see what happened. But they're still undeveloped. The reason they are still undeveloped is because if they were developed the developer would be able to see that John Kennedy was torn to pieces from the front. And they don't want you to see that.

King: Why don't they ...

Garrison: I might say this: our federal government (at least under Lyndon Johnson) has reached the point of such total disregard for the truth, such corruption with regard to fooling the people of the country, that an excellent possibility now exists that they have succeeded in replacing the original autopsy pictures with autopsy pictures of another subject where the wounds fit.

But ...

King: You don't put that past them?

Garrison: Oh, this is the way the United States government operates.
